## Veterinary Surgeon

Most people know a veterinary surgeon as their vet.

Veterinary surgeons diagnose and treat animals daily, and also do routine appointments, like health checks and vaccinations.

## Veterinary Nurse

Veterinary nurses provide supportive care when an animal is treated. They give medication, injections, and anaesthetics to their patients. Vet nurses also assist in surgery and other treatments.



## Veterinary Care Assistant

A veterinary care assistant takes care of the animals that stay at the vet for treatment. This can include feeding animals after surgery and setting up a suitable environment for them to stay in.

## Receptionist

The receptionist answers phone calls and makes appointments with animal owners. They work alongside the other staff to make sure emergencies are seen first.

## Practice Manager

The practice manager oversees the work in the vet practice. They make sure the staff can access training to continue to learn. They also make sure the vets and vet nurses have safe working conditions.

## Marketing Manager

The marketing manager is in charge of the marketing for the vet practice. They may run social media accounts and keep their website up-to-date.



## Bookkeeper

A bookkeeper keeps track of a vet practice's finances. They look at how much money a practice makes and spends, so they can decide when to get new equipment and other important decisions.
